- **The Formal Apprenticeship Training Program**

is reserved for those who have a genuine spiritual aspiration to come to awakening (Enlightenment) and willing to exert themselves in their practice.

- **Tuition**

The tuition of \$1200 is equal to membership in The Zen Society at the Temple Benefactor Level. (Temple Benefactor \$1200 Annually) Payable in monthly installments of \$100 per month.

Includes access to all other Zen Center events at a discounted rate, meals and lodging during One-Day and Weekend Retreats held on campus, and meditation materials.

Partial work-scholarships are available. For students and persons on fixed incomes.

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## **Minimum Requirements**

(Everyone is strongly encouraged to participate at **a level of commitment that is appropriate to their circumstances.**)

**Monthly Dokusan (Private Spiritual Direction) with Seijaku Roshi.**

**Attend Monthly “Buddhism 101 and Beyond” classes held one Sunday evening a month.**

**Volunteer Regularly for (Samu) Work Practice.**

**Exceptions - Family Related *Emergency*, Job Responsibilities, or an illness that may be contagious to others.**
